Port Hacking High School provides a dedicated homework club called “The Strive Hive” after school, Mondays and Wednesdays, from 3.05pm to 4.00pm. Located in the Library, the Club provides students with a structured study environment outside of class time, fostering self-directed learning and independent study skills. The Strive Hive is a great opportunity for students to receive help with homework and/or assessments, as well as support with skill development on a one-on-one basis.

Students are supervised by at least two teaching staff (one from English/ Humanities and one from Mathematics/Science), providing specialised study support across numerous areas of learning.

Students also have access to the full range of computers, library books, and facilities during this study session.

The Strive Hive is made available to students of our school in order to:

- Provide access to computers for word processing, PowerPoint presentations, internet research, printing completed work etc.
- Provide access to all books, encyclopaedias, magazines and other printed resources.
- Gain assistance from teachers on the completion of homework and assignments, developing study skills, research techniques etc.
- Provide a quiet environment for school or recreational reading.
