SCHOOL SPORT – THURSDAYS

We would like to thank parents and students for their patience throughout the COVID-19 period. The sporting activities available have been limited and therefore the financial arrangements for sport were put on hold to account for the restrictions imposed during the winter sports season in Term 2.

This letter is to advise that there has been further relaxing of the restrictions and the following information is to inform parents of how sport will operate on Thursdays in Term 3 up until the end of the winter sport season (Week 6 Term 3).

Please note that sport on Thursday 2nd July (Week 10, Term 2) will run exactly the same as the Thursday just past.

REMAINDER OF WINTER SPORTS SEASON – Term 3, Weeks 1 to 6

On return to school after the winter break, Thursday 23/7/20 Week 1 Term 3, Port Hacking High School will be running its sporting program to meet the revised guidelines as set by the government, in conjunction with the NSW Department of Education,

As we proceed into Term 3, sport will take a more familiar look to what has run prior to the COVID-19 situation.

Grade sports will be heading back to outside of school venues and competitive matches against other schools.

Recreational sports will be returning to venues and using outside providers where required.

Please discuss with your son/daughter their arrangements and commitments for Thursday sport over the next 7 school weeks.

Listed below are the arrangements for each sport and financial commitments and expectations for the remainder of the winter sport season.

These arrangements will also be listed for students on the following school noticeboards:

- 1) The new sports noticeboard in the quad
- 2) The noticeboard outside the PD/H/PE staffroom

Each sport has different arrangements as follows:

Sport Buses:

- Sport buses run at a cost of \$7.00 per student each week. This is to be paid as the student enters the bus.
- Students without bus money may be sent to non-sport. Where possible, students will be allowed to pay the next day.
- Students are to check the two noticeboards regularly during Term 3 in order to be aware of opponent, venue and which bus to catch.
- Period 4 ends at 12.25pm and students are to make their way promptly to the bus bay for transport to the venues.
- Students who catch a bus to and from sport will be dismissed on return to school.



GRADE SPORT

Netball / OzTag / Soccer:

These sports will now play competitive matches at venues off premises against other schools.

Cost: \$7.00 weekly bus fare only – no additional cost.

Basketball:

This sport will now play competitive matches at venues off premises against other schools.

Cost: \$36.00 for the 6 weeks remaining of the winter sport season. This is to be paid to the school office by the end of Week 1 Term 3. (plus **\$7.00** weekly bus fare, payable when entering the bus)

RECREATIONAL SPORTS TRAVELLING BY BUS

Beach Walking: Students are dropped off at Bass and Flinders Point and walk to North Cronulla car park for transport back to school.

Cost: \$7.00 weekly bus fare only – no additional cost.

Tenpin Bowling: This sport takes place at Southgate Bowling Alley. Students are to check the two noticeboards regularly during Term 3 in order to be aware of which bus to catch.

Cost: \$42.00 for the 6 weeks remaining of the winter sport season. This is to be paid to the school office by the end of Week 1 Term 3. (plus **\$7.00** weekly bus fare, payable when entering the bus).

Surfing: This sport takes place at North Cronulla Beach.

Cost: \$7.00 weekly bus fare only – no additional cost.*

*Any fees ordinarily associated with this sport have been removed for this winter season.

Sea Kayaking: This sport takes place at Gunnamatta Bay.

Cost: \$7.00 weekly bus fare only – no additional cost.*

*Any fees ordinarily associated with this sport have been removed for this winter season.

NO COST SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES.

Recreational Walking: Students will meet the supervising teacher in the school quad at 1.05pm. Students will walk off site around the local community under the instructions and supervision of a teacher. They will return to school for 2.30pm dismissal. There is no cost for this activity.

Dance: This sport takes place on school premises. Students meet at the dance studio at 1.05pm. There is no cost for this sport.

Handball: This sport takes place on school premises. Students meet at the quadrangle at 1.05pm. There is no cost for this sport.

Landscaping: This activity takes place on school premises. Students meet at the Industrial Arts block at 1.05pm. There is no cost for this activity.

Sports Rotation/Competition time: This sport will meet in Room 402 each week at 1.05pm before going out for their organised activity. There is no cost for this sport.



PAID SPORTS

Boxercise & Fitness / Weights: This activity runs at Body Fit Gym, Miranda. Instructors are provided and age appropriate training is conducted. Students meet in the school quad half way through lunch. Students walk with teachers to the venue. At approximately 2.30pm students are dismissed from the venue.

Cost: \$20.00 per student (including Members), payable to the school front office by Friday Week 1 Term 3.

*Non-members must pay an additional **\$5.00** each week when the roll is marked.

Yoga: This sport will go ahead at school – students to check the run sheet on the noticeboard for the exact location.

Cost: \$7.00 to be paid to the instructor each week.

Table Tennis: This sport will go ahead at school – students will meet at 1:05pm at the tables located adjacent to the canteen.

Cost: Any fees ordinarily associated with this sport have been removed for this winter season.

Trampolining: This activity runs at Seymour Shaw Park, Miranda. Students meet in the school quad half way through lunch. Students walk with teachers to the venue. At approximately 2.30pm students are dismissed from the venue.

Cost: \$13.00 to be paid to the instructor at the venue each week.

Tennis: This sport runs at Seymour Shaw Park, Miranda. Students meet at the school athletics track at 1.05pm. Students walk with teachers to the venue. At approximately 2.30pm students are dismissed from the venue.

Cost: \$48.00, paid to the school front office by Friday Week 1, Term 3.

Note: Students have been required to pay \$7.00 to the office weekly for the last 6 weeks of Term 2. Coaches are returning for Term 3.

Summer sport selections will take place in Week 2, Term 3. The summer sports season begins in Week 7.

Prompt payment for the current season by the end of Week 1 Term 3 would be appreciated. Any student who will not be able to meet the financial requirements of the winter season's sport please see Mr Barlow ASAP in the PDHPE staffroom to change sports.
