Dear Parents and Carers

On Wednesday 22nd July, students will experience an in-school career development session titled **The Truth Project**. This initiative is to promote positive engagement with career decision making and understanding of post school pathways.

What is 'The Truth Project'?

The Truth Project is designed to empower students to create an inspiring vision for their future. Students in Years 10, 11 and 12 will engage in a program that motivates, educates and resonates. It will enhance the students' knowledge and encourage a more positive post-school journey.

The Truth Project program bridges the gap between young people and the real story behind industries, workplaces, education and their own self-belief.

Year13 is a youth-based organisation whose digital platform <https://year13.com.au/home> creates a space for young people to connect to information and resources on post-school destinations with a focus on youth wellbeing.

Year13 has developed three 60 minute sessions for Years 10, 11 and 12 students utilising their 'motivate, educate, resonate' engagement method. Over the past seven years, *Year13* has analysed trends in how young people consume content and the number of touch points required before they take an action. These interactive sessions mix data, audio visual content, reflection and discussion to encourage active conversation and consideration about pathways with important stakeholders such as parents.

There is no charge for students to participate in this activity.
